

Dual Vocational Training Digital Monitoring Platform


The College has developed an institutional digital platform to support the supervision and monitoring of students participating in the dual vocational education system in collaboration with partner enterprises. The platform facilitates communication, data recording, progress tracking, and performance reporting between the College and industry partners in a centralized and real-time environment.

The system provides comprehensive dashboards displaying the number of students, training outcomes, supervision activities, and enterprise participation. It enables instructors to record supervision visits, monitor student competencies, track training progress, and generate reports efficiently. The platform also integrates information on workplace mentors, training establishments, and cooperation agreements (MOU), allowing systematic oversight of dual vocational training implementation.

Key functions of the platform include:

- Student training progress monitoring and performance evaluation
- Recording of supervision visits and mentoring activities
- Real-time communication and data sharing between the College and enterprises
- Institutional dashboards and statistical reports for management decision-making
- Tracking of enterprise participation and cooperation agreements

The implementation of this digital platform significantly reduces administrative workload, documentation processes, and coordination time for instructors supervising students in industry placements. It enhances efficiency, transparency, and data accuracy while supporting proactive workload management and educational quality assurance.




Number of students: 536


Number of students who have completed vocational training
